Recently in worship we heard 1 Corinthians 12:4-13, which speaks of the varieties of gifts, service, and activities offered by the many members of the one body of Christ, the church. This congregation is a wonderful model of a rich variety of gifts offered to achieve our mission of *Experiencing and Expressing Christ's Love.*

Weekly Sunday school teachers share the stories of Jesus and his love with our children and youth. Ushers and greeters offer the warmth of hospitality as we enter worship. Pew stewards and ushers clean up after we leave worship. Liturgists take seriously their role in leading worship. Our youth recently led a meaningful Mother's Day worship service. The choirs rehearse weekly to learn new anthems to inspire us and recently presented a beautiful cantata, requiring many hours of preparation. Our music staff members prayerfully prepare to coordinate with the themes of the service. Technicians run our sound and video equipment so that all can hear and participate in worship. Parents and others with an affection for youth prepare programs and meals for our weekly Sunday evening youth ministry. During the summer many musicians in our congregation will offer their gifts to God during worship.

Our financial team members conscientiously counts our worship offering, record our giving, pay our bills, monitor our funds, grant endowment funds, and more. The Board of Trustees has nine members with unique expertise who thoughtfully consider the care of our church campus and parsonage, meet with contractors, supervise work, and oftentimes do the labor themselves. A team of gardeners rotate responsibility for hand watering garden beds. Our Staff-Parish Relations Committee supports our staff in various ways.

Special events offer opportunities for a variety of gifts. The rummage sale invited in donors, heavy lifters, sorters, cleaners, pricers, sellers, publicizers....! Not only was it a fundraiser, it was an outreach to the community and an opportunity to build community among our own participants. Some among you are even assisting me with a project for the Bishop's Retirement Celebration, cleaning, sanding, and spraying gourd shards!

There are indeed a variety of opportunities and needs and you as a congregation respond with commitment, enthusiasm, and generous spirits. By no means is this a comprehensive list of all the ways you serve. It is an expression of appreciation for the variety of ways in which you share. It is a joy to be in ministry with you!


SAVE THE DATE!!

There will be no classes for children June 22 so that all may attend the JAZZ IN JUNE service in Fellowship Hall.






Featuring the Tice Valley Jazz Band, led by Bob Sutherland



Ninety minutes after the wreck, while a minister prayed for him, Piper miraculously returned to life on earth with only the memory


