I marvel at the dedication and commitment so generously offered by the entire congregation in order to serve 100 children, youth, and families who are not regular participants in our congregation. Many went "the extra mile" in order to accommodate the large numbers of campers. At the ice cream social about twenty Bibles were set out and offered for families to pick up if their child or family did not have a Bible. All of them were taken!! Several parents spoke with me regarding baptism for the children and questions their children were asking about God. I sensed a renewed interest in the Christian faith on the part of many.

Our opportunity and challenge is to follow up with these families and offer the ministry of Jesus Christ. We have a well established Sunday school under the leadership of Barbara Levander and a wonderful team of teachers and helpers. As Judy Stillman officially retires from youth ministry and moves into small group ministry, a team of volunteers is planning to lead our youth ministry, including Sunday school, youth groups, Sierra Service Project.

Beyond these, I dream of additional small groups to nurture the spiritual formation of adults, so that they are equipped as spiritual leaders in their families, the church, and the community. I envision additional fellowship events for the church family to gather as a body to develop friendships. I believe that a fellowship group for parents of young children and another for parents of youth would be well received. We have a growing number of "empty nesters" who might enjoy spending time together.
